- Collaborates with the Executive Team and General Outing Club Board:

- Implement marketing strategies to increase participation in Outing Club programs and events
- Organize events and fundraisers
- Execute objectives of Strategic Plan including but not limited to; expanding program offerings to children and adults, strengthening partnerships with businesses and organizations, increasing visibility of OC within community
- Participates in select Outing Club Board Committees
- Attends monthly General Board Meetings
- Responds to all member and community inquiries and complaints in a timely and professional manner
- Collaborates with the NL Recreation commission and external groups to review and implement new adult and youth programming in the area.
- Provides detailed bi-monthly report on programs to Outing Club Board
- Performs other duties as assigned
